The only thing more fun than making one of these fast fabric post cards is receiving one in the mail! In class you will learn the basics for creating these 4x6 works of art and the requirements for mailing them to friends and family.

What you need for class:

Sewing machine with zigzag ability. A walking foot is helpful.

Basic sewing needs- rotary cutter, rotary cutting mat, scissors, iron, etc...

Fabric: scraps, fused scraps, one piece of fabric at least 4x6"

Thread: basic sewing tread, thread for embellishment (floss, yarns, cording)

Fast2fuse: at least one 4x6" piece

Batting and other stiff interfacing can be use. This is for the inner part of the post card and makes it stiff enough to mail.

Other embellishments: buttons (small), ribbon, beads, etc. These need to be thin so that the total depth of the card doesn't exceed 1/4".
