

Woven Tablerunner – Material List

Fabrics –

- For the woven center section, use three contrasting colors of fabric – 1 yard each (for a total of 3 yards) *In the sample, two different greens were used for one color @ 1/2 yard each
- Border fabric – 2 yards if a border print is used as in the sample (to avoid piecing the length)
- Binding – 1/3 yard
- Backing – 1.5 yards
- Lightweight fusible interfacing – 1.5 yard

Other materials:

- Long (~3 inch) basting needle
- Spray starch or spray water bottle
- Iron
- Cutting mat and rotary cutter with sharp blade
- 6 x 24 ruler
- Quilting pins
- Sewing machine (Quarter inch and walking foot)
- Piecing thread
- Quilting thread
- Scissors
- Padded, hard backed ironing board (~size of a large cutting board) – this is used to weave the center section so each student should have one of their own

PRIOR TO CLASS:

Cut ten (10) 2 3/4" wide x width of fabric strips from each of the three contrasting fabrics for the center section. If you are using two different fabrics for one of the contrasts, cut five (5) strips of each. You should bring a total of 30 strips.
