## **Class Supply List**

Sewing machine in good working order.

2-1/2 - 5 yards of focus fabric, with at least a 12" repeat.

You will need **7 repeats** of your focus fabric – 6 to make hexagons and one for fillers and to document what your fabric looked like before you sliced it up. The size of your quilt will depend on the size of your repeat: 1 12" repeat can make a quilt @32" x 43" before borders; a 25" repeat make more than enough hexagons for a 35" x 54" quilt before borders.

If the fabric you absolutely LOVE has less than a 12" repeat, go ahead and buy it, but you will need 13 repeats to use it for this technique.

Flat head pins – with the flower tops.

Regular straight pins.

Long ruler to cut strips – whatever you use at home when cutting 3-4" strips.

60 degree triangle ruler

Rotary cutter with fresh blade – extra blades are a good idea

Cutting mat.

Thread.

Scissors.

Extra sewing machine needles for piecing and a spare bobbin.
