WEEK 1 - BERNINA/bernette Machine Embroidery Refresher Course

Learn the tips and tricks of machine embroidery. How to resize a design. Skipping stitches. Create a monogram. Reverse a design. Discuss stabilizers, embroidery thread, and bobbin thread. And so much more! (not all BERNINA/bernette machines have the same functionality).

We will explore your machine and PLAY. The goal of this class is for you to get better acquainted with your embroidery machine so you are comfortable to begin your own embroidery projects.

WEEK 2 - BERNINA/bernette Machine Embroidery

Towel Embroidery and Applique February 16th - 11 am to 3 pm, \$50.00



Don't want to give your grandchild another gift that ends up in the bottom of the toybox? Make them something they'll use every day!

Personalized towels make great gifts - and not just for kids! Dish towels - hand towels - bath towels - wash cloths - even golf towels.

In this class you will learn to to embroider and/or applique on terry cloth with both a top and bottom stabilizer (provided by PATCHES). You can also embroider on tea (flour sack) towels.

You pick the design - so many to choose from!

Embroidery thread - 40 weight- suggested colors - white - green black - orange

Embroidery needles

Embroidery bobbin thread - 60 weight or higher

WOF fabric - at least 12 inches for the runner. Suggested = Green, black, or something Irish.

PATCHES will provide stabilizer and fabric pieces for applique.

PREPARING YOUR QUILT FOR THE LONGARM

- QUILT The quilt top, backing, and batting should be provided separately. Unpinning or unbasting will be provided as a specialty service, if required. Patches does not accept fused or spray basted quilts.
- The quilt top and backing should be well pressed. If seamed, the backing should have the selvage trimmed and pressed open. Quilt backing edges should be even and the backing should be squared. Squaring of backing will be provided as a specialty service, if required. Selvages should be removed from the seam only. It is fine to keep the selvages on the outer edges of the backing.
- The seams on the quilt top may be pressed as you desire except where there are multiple seam intersections, creating a "bump". These should be pressed open to distribute the thickness.
- Threads should be trimmed on the top and back of the quilt top and backing. Dark threads on the wrong side of the quilt top and back may show through if the quilt has light colored fabrics.
- Backing and batting must be approximately 5" to 6" wider all around the quilt top. This is necessary in order to load the quilt into the machine frame.
- Batting can be spliced for you as a specialty service.
- If you provide your own thread for quilting, it must be suitable for longarm machine quilting. Extra thread is always required to avoid delays that affect scheduling.
- The quilt top should not have any three-dimensional embellishments such as buttons, charms, beads, etc. Save all embellishments until after the quilt top has bee quilted.
- Please alert the longarm quilter at the time of presentation if you intend for your quilt to hang in a show. The longarm quilter knows what the judges are looking for and will prepare the quilt accordingly. Expect to pay more for "show quality" quilting.
- The usual turn-around time is 4-6 weeks.
- Rush jobs are accepted buy may incur extra charges.



Most classes offered by **PATCHES** are available to meet **YOUR SCHEDULE** (*during regular store hours*). Classes will still be offered at a specific day/time. The class description will list the approximate number of hours required. If you aren't available when the class is offered, **PATCHES** can arrange to schedule the class at a time that is convenient to you! (*This doesn't apply to guest instructors*)

PATCHES you will also offer several classes on an ongoing basis that you can choose from.

BORDERS, BACKING, & BINDINGS with Jackie B. Wednesday, February 28, 2024 10 am to 12 pm \$25.00 Learn the techniques to make the center of your quilt POP by framing it in just the right BORDER, BACKING, and BINDING.

After you finish piecing the center of your quilt, it is imperative that the borders are applied in the correct manner. If not, your quilt will never lay flat and the idea that "you can quilt it out" is just not true. Extra fluff is a quilter's nightmare.

In this class we will also cover the various ways to treat the edges of your quilts. Flanges, two color binding, prairie points and scallops are just a few of the techniques we will cover.

This is a lecture only class. No class supply list is required for this class. However, if you'd like to bring in some quilts for discussion, please do so.

Create a 30" X 44" oval (or larger) or a round area rung using the jelly roll (or rolls) of your choice. Jelly rolls are cute, round fabric "treats" consisting of 40 to 42 strips of fabric. Each strip measures 2.5" X 42". If you choose to make your own 2 1/2" strips, you will need approximately 3 yards of fabric for every 50 yards of Bosal jelly roll batting.

You can customize this rug to your liking depending on the colors, and prints of fabric you choose. Brighten up your sewing room, decorate a child's room, or use coordinating colors to create a rug to complement any room in your home. Or try using red, white, and pink for a Valentine's Day rug. The possibilities are endless!.

This project takes just 2 yards each of a focus fabric and 2 yards of a coordinate/contrast fabric - or more if you want a larger quilt.




